Dear Parents,

On Monday 16 July, there will be a short **Parents' evening** to discuss reports if needed (4-6pm). The end of year reports will be sent out to you on Friday and this meeting is an opportunity to discuss the report if you feel you wish to. There are no formal appointments this time; it is a drop in session. Teachers will be in their classrooms. Your child's **end of year report** will include an indication of whether your child is working at ARE (Age Related Expectations), above or towards - this is linked to the National Curriculum standards used in all schools and is a guide to key performance indicators that we aim for in each year group from Key Stage 1 upwards. If your child is in Reception, the report will indicate whether your child is Emerging, Expected or Exceeding the end of key stage goals. Nursery reports do not include this level of information.

The teachers for Year 2 and Year 6 for September 2018 are as follows:

Year 1 Navy will become Year 2 Amber with Ms Proctor, Mrs Nixon and Mrs Sanchez in the current Year 2 classroom.

Year 1 Azure will become Year 2 Saffron with Ms Moore and Ms Manlow in the current Year 3 classroom which is upstairs in the main school building. We will send a letter to Azure parents about the drop off and pick up points for the new term over the next few days.

Year 5 Pearl will become Year 6 Jet with Mr Kendall, Mrs Ashley-Binge and Mrs Taylor.

Year 5 Silver will become Year 6 Onyx with Mrs Sunda, Mrs Ashley-Binge and Mrs Taylor.

Both Year 6 classrooms will remain upstairs.

Our new Nursery building has been delayed and is now set to be completed in December 2018. For the autumn term, Nursery will be held in its current room along with the current Year1 classroom to allow more space for the larger number of children who are joining Nursery in September; some of whom will be staying for the new 30 hours provision.

Year 1, Year 3 and Year 5 will be accommodated in the outdoor classrooms in September.
