



Letter from the Headteacher

Dear Parents and Children,

I am writing to inform you of my decision to retire at the end of this year. I have been the Headteacher at Spring Grove since 1995 and have enjoyed supporting and nurturing many children and members of staff through the school during almost twenty five years. After much thought and deliberation, I have decided to retire at the end of December.

The Governing Body is beginning its search for the next Headteacher this month which is why I am giving you this news so early and you may hear from friends or colleagues that an advert has gone live for my replacement. The process of recruiting a new Head takes some months so the Governors are planning well in advance and starting their search early. If the search is successful, a new Headteacher will begin working here in January 2020. If we are not successful straight away, I will stay on a little longer until the right person is found.

I will probably continue doing some education consultancy work across schools within the Local Authority but feel that the time is right for me to make this decision as I have a rather “big birthday” approaching.
